

Scuba Diving/Snorkelling Try Dive with Dorset Diving Services For ages 8 years old and above

Read the following paragraphs carefully.

This statement, which includes a Medical Questionnaire, a Liability Release and Assumption of Risk Agreement (Statement of Risks and Liability), Non-Agency Disclosure and Acknowledgment and the Discover Scuba Diving Knowledge and Safety Review, informs you of some potential risks involved in scuba diving and of the conduct required of you during Try Dive & Snorkelling session. If you are a minor, your parent or guardian must read this form and sign at the end.

You will also need to learn important safety rules regarding breathing and equalization while scuba diving from your professional instructor/diverset. Scuba diving and the use of scuba equipment without proper supervision or instruction can result in serious injury or death. You must be instructed in its use under the direct supervision of a qualified instructor.

Non-Agency Disclosure and Acknowledgement Agreement

I understand and agree that Dorset Diving Services, and/or any individual Instructors and/or Divemaster's associated with the program in which I am participating, are licensed to use various PADI Trademarks and to conduct PADI training, but are not agents, employees or franchisees of PADI EMEA Ltd., PADI Americas, Inc., or its parent, subsidiary and affiliated corporations ("PADI"). I further understand that Member business activities are independent, and are neither owned nor operated by PADI, and that while PADI establishes the standards for PADI diver training programs, it is not responsible for, nor does it have the right to control, the operation of the Members' business activities and the day-to-day conduct of PADI programs and supervision of divers by the Members or their associated staff.

I understand that I am not participating in a PADI program and accept that I will not be a qualified diver or receive any PADI certification(s) after this Scuba Diving try dive ran by Dorset Diving Services.

Medical Questionnaire

Scuba diving is an exciting and demanding activity. To scuba dive you must not be extremely overweight or out of condition. Diving can be strenuous under certain conditions. Your respiratory and circulatory systems must be in good health. All body air spaces must be normal and healthy. A person with heart trouble, a current cold or congestion, epilepsy, asthma, a severe medical problem, or who is under the influence of alcohol or drugs, should not dive. If taking medication, consult your doctor before participating in this program. The purpose of the Medical Questionnaire is to find out if you should be examined by a physician before participating in recreational scuba diving. A positive response to a question does not necessarily disqualify you from diving. A positive response means that there is a pre-existing condition that may affect your safety while diving and you must seek the advice of a physician.

Please answer the following questions on your past and present medical history with a YES or NO. If you are not sure, answer YES. If any of these items apply to you, we must request that you consult with a physician prior to participating in scuba diving. Your instructor/divemaster will supply you with a Medical Statement and Guidelines for Recreational Scuba Diver's Physical Examination to take to a physician.

Do you currently have an ear infection?	
Do you have a history of ear disease, hearing loss or problems with balance?	
Are you currently suffering from a cold, congestion, sinusitis, or bronchitis?	
Do you have a history of respiratory problems, severe attacks of hay fever or allergies, or lung disease?	
Have you had a collapsed lung (pneumothorax) or history of chest surgery?	
Do you have active asthma or history of emphysema or tuberculosis?	
Are you currently taking medication that carries a warning about any impairment of your physical or mental abilities?	
Do you have behavioural health, mental or psychological problems or a nervous system disorder?	
Are you or could you be pregnant?	
Do you have a history of colostomy?	
Do you have a history of heart disease or heart attack, heart surgery or blood vessel surgery?	
Do you have a history of high blood pressure, angina, or take medication to control blood pressure?	
Are you over 45 and have a family history of heart attack or stroke?	
Do you have a history of bleeding or other blood disorders?	
Do you have a history of diabetes?	
Do you have a history of seizures, blackouts or fainting, convulsions or epilepsy or take medications to prevent them?	
Do you have a history of back, arm of leg problems following an injury, fracture or surgery?	
Do you have a history of fear of closed or open spaces or panic attacks (claustrophobia or agoraphobia)?	

Statement of Risk and Liability

This is a statement in which you are informed of the risks of snorkelling and scuba diving. The statement also sets out the circumstances in which you participate in the diving programme at your own risk. Your signature on this statement is required as proof that you have received and read this statement. It is important that you read the contents of this statement before signing it. If you do not understand anything contained in this statement, then please discuss it with your instructor. If you are a minor, this form must also be signed by a parent or guardian.

Warning

Snorkelling and scuba diving have inherent risks which may result in serious injury or death. Diving with compressed air involves certain inherent risks; decompression sickness, embolism or other hyperbaric injury can occur that require treatment in a recompression chamber. Open water diving trips that are necessary for this programme, may be conducted at a site that is remote, either by time or distance or both, from such a recompression chamber. Snorkelling and scuba diving are

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physically strenuous activities, and you will be exerting yourself during this diving programme. You must advise truthfully and fully inform the dive professionals and the facility through which this programme is offered of your medical history.

Acceptance of Risk

I understand and agree that neither the dive professionals conducting this programme, any dive professional, nor the facility through which this programme is conducted, Dorset Diving Services nor their affiliate or subsidiary corporations, nor any of their respective employees, officers, agents, contractors or assigns accept any responsibility for any death, injury or other loss suffered by me to the extent that it result from my own conduct or any matter or condition under my control that amounts to my own contributory negligence.

In the absence of any negligence or other breach of duty by the dive professionals conducting this programme, any dive professional, the facility through which this programme is offered, Dorset Diving Services and all parties referred to above, my participation in this diving programme is entirely at my own risk.
